## Join Us For The CAC Summit in Washington, DC

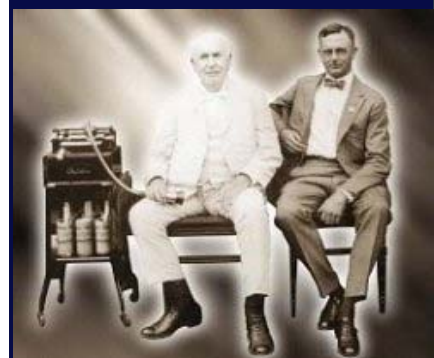
Dolbey will be traveling to Washington, DC to speak at the CAC AHIMA Coding Summit on April 13-14th.
